HEALTHIER GENERATION - PREPARATION PHASE**

Sullivan 180 is a non-profit organization whose mission is to foster and support community efforts to improve the health of all residents. Our goal is to turn this ranking around by 180 degrees. With the understanding that this is a long term effort, Sullivan 180 is committed to change by degrees, the kind of slow, steady and enduring transformation that is thoughtfully conceived and implemented.

The Empowering a Healthier Generation Program is a Sullivan 180 multi-phase initiative to improve and promote the social, physical and environmental health and wellness of Sullivan County schools. The program provides funding, technical assistance and additional partner resources.

Prospective applicants are encouraged to read through these documents thoroughly to become familiar with the program resources and requirements before submitting an application. **Sullivan 180 staff are available to assist and answer questions any time during the process.**

ELIGIBILITY

The HEALTHIER GENERATION GRANT PROGRAM makes funding available to public schools in Sullivan County to support stipends up to \$500.00 per semester for Healthier Generation Advisors who will assist in assessing the district wellness policy and establish a school Healthier Generation Committee. Healthier Generation Preparation Grants will be made available to underwrite the costs up to \$1000.00 per semester for educational programs, staff training, supplies, events and/or resources that support the work of the school's Healthier Generation Committee. This time will be viewed as preparation to then participate in a larger competition. The Healthier Generation Advisory Stipends and Preparation Grants will be renewable each semester for three semesters.

Timeline of Preparation phase for Empowering a Healthier Generation competition:

Semester 1: January 2021 – June 2021

Semester 2: September 2021 – December 2021

Semester 3: January 2022 – June 2022

HEALTHIER GENERATION ADVISOR STIPEND UP TO \$500.00 PER SEMESTER FOR 3 SEMESTERS MAX OF \$1,500.00

The Healthier Generation Advisor will:

- Launch a school based Healthier Generation Committee to inspire healthy behaviors and improve the health and well-being of students, staff and parents.
- Engage students and colleagues as active committee members.
- Support their District Wellness Committee and the development and/or implementation of the Wellness Policy.
- Attend regular meetings of the Sullivan Healthier Generation Council and act as a liaison to the school, bringing back valuable ideas, trainings and resources to their school community.

The Healthier Generation Preparation Grant is a resource to support programs and projects that are identified by the Healthier Generation Committee. The Healthier Generation Grant is administered through Sullivan Renaissance with funding support from the Rowley Foundation and the Gerry Foundation.

Examples of possible projects:

- Materials for outdoor learning spaces
- Creation or enhancement of edible gardens
- Establishing healthy fundraisers and celebrations
- Speakers, workshops or trainings for teachers, students and parents
- Other projects in consultation with Sullivan 180

PROJECT DOCUMENTATION

A separate grant application with a budget and supporting documentation is required.

A letter of support from the appropriate school building principle is required.

Progress reports, including photos if applicable, as well as Healthier Generation Committee updates may be requested.
